


Cathedral Window by Machine

Window- Cut 1 sq.- 9 ½ in on point (this is the picture you want to see. Make sure its in the center of the square as the bias fold overs will cover some of the edges.)

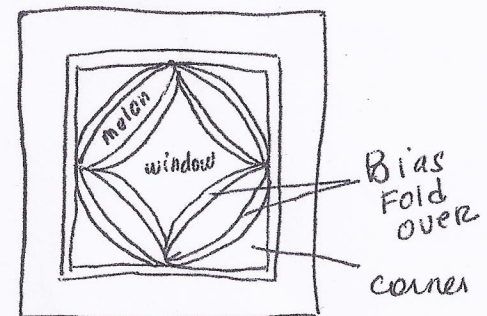
Cut 4 squares- 7 ½ in for the part that shows through the melon shapes. *yellow*

Cut 8 Squares- 7 ½ in for the bias fold overs. (This fabric frames the window. These could also be 4 one color and 4 another color) *Blue*

Cut 2 squares- 7 in. for corner colors. If directional fabric is used cut each square diagonally (one from left to right and 1 from right to left)  *green*

First border- cut 2 strips- 1 1/8 in wide. *Coral*

Second border- cut 2 strips- 4 in wide. *Brown*



Blue
Binding- 3 strips 1 3/8 in. (binding color) and 3 strips 1 *yellow* 3/4 (accent color) for No Hand Sewing Binding.

Bring all necessary sewing tools. Fabric. Thread to match the fabric you have chosen for the bias fold over fabric. Thread to quilt your piece. Thread to match the accent fabric of your binding. Lunch and a happy face. Class starts a 9:30 am but the church will be open at 9 with coffee and sweets by Marie.

Cathedral Window by Machine

Window- 9 ½ sq. cut on point if directional

Cut 4- 7 ½ sqs for the part that shows in the mellon shapes.

Cut 8- 7 ½ sqs for the bias fold overs. Press in half with wrong sides together or cut 4 of one color and 4 of another.

Cut 2 sqs – 7 in sq. if directional cut each square diagonally (one from left to right and one from right to left). 

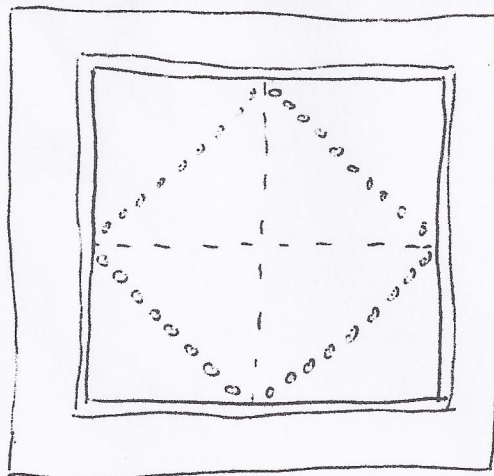
First border- cut 2-11/8 strips.

Second border- cut 2- 4 in strips.

Binding- 3 strips 1 3/8 and 3 strips 1 ¾ for No Hand sewing Binding.

Lay out 4 squares of the mellon color (background).

Lay 8 pressed triangles onto 4 squares. Baste around edges inside seam allowance. Stitch 4 squares together using ¼ in seam. Press open. Layer window fabric over the seams. Pin bias edge over window. Add corner fabrics if using. Pin bias edge over corners. Add borders. Stitch bias edges using a narrow zigzag stitch and matching thread.(width 1-length 1). Layer and quilt to finish. Add binding.
